

Dogwood Social Dance Club

The Dogwood Social Dance Club holds a weekly 2 hour evening social dance most months of the year in the Mike Butler Room which has a spacious parquet wood dance floor. The dance is for people of all dance skill levels to enjoy ballroom dancing (waltz, foxtrot, quickstep, Foxtrot, jive, West Coast swing) and Latin (rhumba, merengue, salsa, mambo, tango, nightclub two step and bachata).

These are done with partners. Singles are welcome. There are occasional line dances thrown in during the course of dance evenings. Music is provided by volunteer DJs.

There are no lessons but experienced dancers are encouraged to help beginners with their dance steps. The emphasis is on having fun.

Dancers must be members of the Dogwood Society and pay an annual activity fee of \$10 which admits them to all dances. Occasionally, we have a live band. An extra charge may be added as required for those events.

Dances will be held in accordance with health directives from the provincial health officer.
